Barry Stein is a self-taught sculptor known for his highly detailed bronze wildlife sculptures. Inspired by a deep connection to nature, his work reflects careful observation and a commitment to capturing the character, movement, and presence of animals in their natural environments.

Based in Oregon, Stein spends extensive time in the field studying wildlife and their surroundings, translating those experiences into sculptural form. His process begins with carving in wood—a demanding medium that allows for exceptional precision and detail. Once complete, the piece is cast in bronze through a multi-stage process involving mold-making, wax casting, and finishing, resulting in sculptures that are both technically refined and visually dynamic.

Stein's work is distinguished by its attention to detail, from the musculature of large animals to the subtle textures of feathers, fur, and natural terrain. Whether depicting powerful wildlife or more whimsical subjects, his sculptures convey a strong sense of realism and vitality.

His work is included in prestigious collections worldwide and has been displayed in major hotels and international venues. In addition, his sculptures have been presented as official gifts by the executive branch of the United States government, reflecting a high level of recognition and distinction.
