French artist Fred Allard reimagines portraiture by replacing faces with the objects and symbols that tell a person's story. His mixed-media sculptures preserve everyday items-from luxury handbags and sneakers to soda cans and shopping bags-transforming familiar objects into contemporary works of art.

Working with resin and found objects, Allard explores themes of identity, memory, consumer culture, and personal history. Each piece reflects the connection between the individual and the world around them, blurring the line between fine art and everyday life.

His bold, collectible works have earned international recognition and can be found in galleries and private collections around the world.
